

WJ Groundwater – Lead Driller

Details:

- The principal function of this position is to lead the drilling operation of a rotary drilling rig for the installation of wells, boreholes, and piezometers within the UK.
- The works includes for the safe setup, operation and maintenance of our drilling rigs and equipment on our dewatering, I&M, In-tunnel, and ground source open loop projects.
- It is our goal to train up the candidate to become an experienced Lead Driller in all our drilling disciplines. In this period, you will be given both internal and external training to allow the use of plant and equipment to facilitate your role (SSSTS, Telehandler, RTFL, Slinger, Banksman, Confined Space etc.).

Must have:

- NVQ Level 2 in land drilling.
- CPCS card with relevant plant competency designations.
- CSCS card.
- Full UK driving licence.
- Minimum 3 years' experience within the construction industry at a lead driller level.
